

Instructions for preparing outlines when submitting a key project application (Status: July 2021)

A Project outline

The maximum 6-page idea draft (Arial 11 or similar font) is to be structured as follows and to be sent to antrag-wissenschaft@ekfs.de:

1. Formal data

- Project title
- Applicant responsible; applicant institution; complete contact data (email), co-applicants, project duration in months, sum total funding applied for

Notes: i) Funding approval recipient can only be an institute of higher education, university hospital or extramural research institution in Germany; ii) Project managers of a currently ongoing EKFS funding project are eligible to apply again only after completion and publication of the results of this project.

2. Summary

Half-page summary of the planned project

3. Hypothesis / Issue

- Brief explanation of the hypothesis/issue addressed by the project
- What is it that constitutes the specific originality of the project?

4. Rationale for the groundbreaking nature of the project

- Reason(s) why the project is considered to have groundbreaking potential (e.g. evidence of a significant, previously missing causal link, proof-of-principle, refutation of an accepted theory)
- Specific consequences that may emerge for the field of research (scenarios)

5. Reason(s) for the applicant group's particular suitability

- List of the 5 own publications most important for the project
- Presentation of the expertise, preliminary work and infrastructure of the applicant work group in an international comparison, unique selling points of the applicants with respect to the planned project's prospect of success
- Optionally – while stating in full the source of the expert reviewer opinion – statements regarding the applicant's qualifications and expertise can be quoted from existing expert reviewer opinions from other application procedures.

6. Project implementation strategy

- Summarized presentation of the experimental approach
- Key cooperations within the project
- Rough schedule and time requirements

7. Resources

Rough planning:

- of the total resources required
- of the institutional or other funding available to the project. This ought to cover at least approx. 1/3 of the total costs.
- of the funds to be applied for from EKFS (stated in EUR):
 - of the personnel positions to be funded
 - estimate of non-monetary resources
 - indication in % as to which proportion of weekly working hours is going to be utilized for the project in the event of funding approval

The application sum total in the outline may not be exceeded in the full application.

8. Declaration

Declaration as to whether the project application presented or a similar project application has previously been submitted to another funding entity. In the event of a preceding rejection of the project application by another funding entity, we request notification of the reasons for rejection or of the reviewers' votes to the extent possible. In the event that a negative expert reviewers' opinion is presented, we request a point-by-point-response to the criticisms; the modifications performed in comparison to the rejected application should be marked in the outline or at least explained in an accompanying letter.

By signing, the applicant and co-applicants obligate themselves to comply with the "Recommendations for ensuring good scientific practice" (*Empfehlungen zur Sicherung guter wissenschaftlicher Praxis*) issued by DFG (German Research Foundation) as revised in 2013.

B Appendices

The following information is requested for each of the lead applicants and co-applicants, if applicable (summarized in one PDF file per person)

1. CV in tabular form (max. 3 pages) without photo
2. List of publications from the current year and the past 4 years in accordance with the template below. Please list only peer-reviewed original publications and reviews (each category on separate lists) while citing the *journal impact factors*. Please include a list of all authors, highlighting the applicant author (bold font) and stating the title. Please do not enclose any publications or manuscripts. Please state your current *h*-index (Hirsch index).
3. List of currently ongoing and concluded third-party funding for the last 5 years (applicant, title, funding entity, term and funding amount)
4. Voluntary declaration of consent for storage of your data in accordance with the sample below

Template for list of publications

- 1) Specification of peer-reviewed original publications and reviews (each category on separate lists); only publications are to be cited which have been published or are in print.
- 2) List of all authors while highlighting the applicant author (bold font)

- 3) Indication of Journal Impact Factors (a decimal value)
- 4) In the last two columns, the number of first authorships (FA) and last authorships (LA) using consecutive numbers
